Cost/Insurance Reimbursement/Appointments: It is important that you check with the facility you chose for testing to determine potential cost and/or insurance coverage, and appointment details. Cost and insurance coverage may be variable depending on facility and type of insurance.

**Guide:**

1. Student should check with their insurance company concerning their coverage for this testing prior to making an appointment. ISU Student Insurance does provide benefits for testing which is medically necessary. Please contact the Student Insurance Office for benefit information.
2. Student may call Student Access and Accommodation Services (SAAS) at 309-438-5853 to inquire about testing available on campus.
3. On campus testing is available for a fee. This fee is not reimbursable by insurance but payment plan options are available.
4. Schedule appointment with Coordinator in SAAS to receive Psychological Services introductory packet.
5. Turn completed packet into SAAS or Psychological Services.

6. If accepted for testing, it will include three appointments. Each appointments is up to three hours in length.
7. If medication is recommended from testing, student will be referred to their own healthcare provider of Student Health Services.
